Today and always, the Virginia State Police Family remembers and honors Trooper Nathan-Michael William Smith, VSP Badge # 1844, for his service and dedication to serving the Citizens of Virginia. Tragically on September 21, 2015, while responding to an emergency call for help at a crash scene his patrol car ran off the left side of an I-295 exit ramp and crashed into the wood line. Trooper Smith succumbed to his injuries becoming the 61st Virginia State Police Trooper to pay the Ultimate Sacrifice while performing his official duties. Trooper Smith had served with the Virginia State Police for 15 months and was assigned to Division 1 - Richmond, Area 7.

Nathan is remembered as a respected trooper with a contagious smile who always thought about the well being of his fellow troopers and the citizens that he served before himself. At the age of 27, Nathan was a beloved husband and father of two children. And he was doing what he loved - serving as a trooper. A servant and humanitarian by nature, Trooper Smith is missed, always remembered, and honored for his service by all that knew him.
